The Department of Prehospital EMS at Westchester Community College is offering an **EMS Management Certificate** designed for current and future leaders in EMS. The EMS Management program will provide students with the knowledge, skills, and experience needed to effectively coordinate a response to emergency situations as well as manage the day to day operations of an EMS System. The certificate program develops the EMT or paramedic’s management level perspective and ability to assume responsible positions that affect procedures and influence policy.

Many highly experienced EMTs and paramedics lack a formal educational background. This certificate gives these professionals a chance to look at the larger picture and to participate in critical thinking and planning exercises, within the context of a systems approach to EMS. Graduates will likewise be better prepared to participate in planning and decision making within the EMS System.
